Dr. Stanley's participation reflected her commitment to academic excellence and thoughts of leadership in the fields of management education and strategic communication.


Her presence at the summit not only elevated the profile of our institution but also reaffirmed her dedication in fostering global academic engagement.

HIGHLIGHT OF THE MONTH










